Month to Celebrate the 100th Anniversary of the First Recorded Map in Cathedral City August 2025

***WHEREAS**, the City of Cathedral City, California, which was incorporated in 1981, is approaching the 100th anniversary of the first recorded map of the city; and*

***WHEREAS**, the first map of the city was filed August 28, 1925, and encompassed land west of Date Palm Drive to Cathedral Canyon, approximately 3 blocks north, and up to 3 blocks south; and*

***WHEREAS**, the first map established original street names to identify significant persons or landmarks including Date Palm Drive, Van Fleet Avenue, Allen Avenue, Glenn Avenue, Plumley Place, Grove Street, Cathedral Canyon Drive and Broadway; and*

***WHEREAS**, the residents of Cathedral City have contributed significantly to the city's unique and rich history and vibrant community over the past 100 years; and*

***WHEREAS**, we celebrate the past, honor the present, and look forward to the future with optimism and enthusiasm; and*

***WHEREAS**, we recognize and honor the contributions of all residents who have played a role in shaping Cathedral City into the thriving community it is today.*

***NOW, THEREFORE, WE**, the City Council of the City of Cathedral City, do hereby proclaim August 2025 as the month to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of the First Recorded Map of the City and encourage all residents to participate in the activities and events that will mark this important milestone in our city's history.*
